## Referral Pathway for Burns Outreach Service



## **Aim of Service:**

The Burns Outreach Service is a Specialist Nursing Service which provides support and education to Healthcare Professionals and Patients in the management of Burn Injury within the catchment areas of Greater Glasgow & Clyde, Lanarkshire, Ayrshire and Forth Valley Health Boards.

## **Eligible Criteria**

**Adult Service / Children > 16** 

Patients currently in other Hospitals (ITU and HDU) or Community who require Specialist Burns nursing input or require assessment of burns prior to admission to specialised Burns Unit at GRI. Only patients that are not able to attend Burns Clinic

Patients who are being discharged from any hospital with complex Burns wounds which requires Specialist Nursing input Patients who will find frequent attendance at Burns outpatients difficult due to mobility or other co-morbidity problems but require input from Specialist Nurse
