Transient ischaemic attack (TIA): acute onset neurological dysfunction caused by focal spinal cord, brain or retina ischaemia with no acute infarct.



\*CTB: if anticoagulated, ongoing neurology, recurrent/crescendo symptoms

\*\*Risk Factors: Hypertension, Diabetes, AF, Prev. CVA, Smoking, FHx, Prev. MI, Angina, ETOH XS, Hyperlipidemia. **Discuss if High Risk**
