

Title	Mental Health Referrals
Applies to	All clinical staff both departments
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Mental health assessment units (MHAU)

GG&C are setting up 2 MHAU's in the city. They will be at Leverndale and Stobhill Hospitals.

Patients will go there from the following sources:-

- Scottish Ambulance Service
- Police Scotland
- Redirection of walk-ins from QEUH, RAH and GRI EDs.

Normal CPN service to ED's will resume but response time may be longer as some of these staff will be manning the MHAU's.

Consultant psychiatry support also available via local switchboard

Pathway

- COVID-19 positive
- COVID-19 suspected (symptoms)
- Significant overdoses requiring treatment or ECG monitoring
- Significant DSH wounds requiring multiple sutures or obvious onward specialty referral
- Patient unable to undertake assessment
- Requiring trolley
- Suicidal with significant risk of absconding

If yes, patient remains in ED



- Complete GG&C ED Mental Health triage and risk assessment tool - 1st page
- Phone local MHAU (Stobhill 0141 201 3136 / Leverndale 0141 211 6627
- Dress DSH wound, if present
- If in doubt, check with ED Senior
- Give patient redirection advice leaflet
- Self transfer or by taxi
- Ask Front Desk to scan notes on to Portal

PATIENT REDIRECTION LEAFLET TO ADULT MENTAL HEALTH ASSESSMENT UNITS (AMHAU)

During the COVID pandemic we have temporarily changed the location where many patients with a mental health problem are assessed and treated. This will allow you to be seen in the safest environment possible.
