Headache Discharge

If discharging an adult patient following an attendance with a non traumatic headache

Please ensure all the following signs & symptoms are considered and excluded:

For use with over 15s only

Headache reached a maximum intensity within 1 hour*		
Age more than 40		
Neck pain or stiffness		
Witnessed loss of consciousness		
Onset during exertion		
Thunderclap headache (instantly peaking pain)		
Limited neck flexion on examination		

If the answer to any of these questions is yes, then discussion & review with senior on duty is required

Not for patients with new neurological deficits, previous aneurysms, SAH, brain tumours, or history of recurrent headaches (\geq 3 episodes over the course of \geq 6 months)

^{*}In patients with thunderclap headache, unenhanced CT of the brain should be performed as soon as possible and preferably within 12 hours of onset
