Your doctor has diagnosed you with

Due to this health problem you have been advised to stop driving until you have further investigations. **If you become unwell whilst driving it may cause an accident placing you and others at risk.**

It is your responsibility and legal requirement to tell the DVLA.

We will send a letter to your GP telling them of your diagnosis and any further investigations or treatment you need.

What to expect next

The DVLA aims to make a decision and contact you within six weeks of receiving your complete medical information. They may contact your GP or hospital specialist for further information, and you may be asked to attend appointments for further investigation.
