Dear Parent/Carer,

Your child has been seen and discharged from the Emergency Department (ED) with a soft tissue injury or limp. You should have been advised that we would expect their symptoms to settle within 7-10 days.

If your child is still having symptoms **7 days after they started**, we would be happy to arrange an ED clinic appointment for your child to be reviewed. ED clinics take place on Thursday mornings and you can arrange an appointment by calling the ED on the telephone number above.

Please return to the ED sooner (do not wait to make an appointment) if your child

- develops fever
- is getting worse despite painkillers
- develops redness/swelling of any part of the leg
- stops walking

If we do not hear from you within 10 days of your 1st visit, we will assume your child's symptoms have resolved and a clinic appointment is not required.
