

# **IRH SAS PAEDIATRIC BYPASS**

Current bypass: \* **All under 2s irrespective of condition** \*

Given the ongoing clinical risk and concern, SAS have agreed to a phased implementation from **23rd November, 2021** which will see the following conditions by-pass IRH for 2-<16 year olds:

1. Cardiac arrest <16y
2. Trauma Tool positive <16y
3. Deformed limb in <16y
4. Head injury with LOC (independent predictor of significance on CT)
5. Status epilepticus <16y
6. Possible Diabetic Ketoacidosis (hi Ketones and Hi BM)
7. Suspected meningitis
8. PEWS > 3
9. Exacerbation of a treatment already under RHC for (thinking of those kids with chronic complex conditions under specialist care)
10. Overdoses (can call ED for advice if needed)
11. <16y that has seen another healthcare professional for same condition in the last week (this is often a predictor for admission/longer watch)

SAS crews will be supported by prof to prof advice in the first instance.
