Trauma day learning outcomes:

- 1. A-E assessment Discussion of primary survey & initial approach to the trauma patient
- 2. C-spine immobilisation demonstration of spinal immobilisation with log rolling
- 3. Brief overview of chest trauma ATOMFC (airway obstruction, tension ptx, open ptx, massive htx, flail chest, cardiac tamponade) and demonstration of esssential equipment
- 4. Awareness of major haemorrhage protocol/pelvic binders/FAST scan
- 5. AVPU/GCS head injury investigation and management Talk thro of GCS and intial neuro assessment including cranial nerves
- 6. Radiology in trauma covering guidelines and review of CTs on PACS
