

## **Trauma day learning outcomes:**

1. A-E assessment – Discussion of primary survey & initial approach to the trauma patient
2. C-spine immobilisation – demonstration of spinal immobilisation with log rolling
3. Brief overview of chest trauma - ATOMFC (airway obstruction, tension ptx, open ptx, massive htx, flail chest, cardiac tamponade) and demonstration of essential equipment
4. Awareness of major haemorrhage protocol/pelvic binders/FAST scan
5. AVPU/GCS - head injury investigation and management – Talk thro of GCS and initial neuro assessment including cranial nerves
6. Radiology in trauma covering guidelines and review of CTs on PACS
